opens the submission period for the

Heinz A. Oertli-Prize 2024 for innovative ophthalmic surgery

The prize rewards **outstanding work in the field of ophthalmic surgery** that deals with the mechanisms and procedures, its instrumentation, results, effects and implications on the anatomy and physiology of the visual organ.

Eligible for the award are works by Swiss authors who have carried them out in Switzerland or abroad, as well as scientific studies originating in Switzerland, irrespective of the nationality of the candidate.

The prize is endowed with CHF 25,000 and can be awarded to an individual as well as to a group of researchers; it can also be awarded in equal parts to two prize winners.

The Board of Trustees of the Alfred Vogt-Foundation decides on the award of the prize. The same work may not be submitted a second time. There is no right of appeal against the decision of the Board of Trustees.

Papers must be submitted in English by **31 March 2024** to the Alfred Vogt-Foundation website www.alfred-vogt-stiftung.ch including the following pdf documents:

- Curriculum vitae with list of publications
- Executive summary of the scientific work (max. 2 pages)
- Publications that relate to the submitted work
