Workshop description

In this workshop, we shine a light on bias in teaching and learning. This begins with curriculum design and materials that universities use to inform and guide students and potential students, and plays a role in course materials, teaching styles, assessment formats and student evaluations. The workshop also goes beyond these formal aspects of third-level teaching and learning by addressing how to ensure that everyone feels they belong in the classroom, lab space, and fieldwork settings. The workshop introduces general research and literature on bias and then applies this body of knowledge to different equality grounds (such as gender, ethnicity, LGBTI, etc.), as covered in the UZH Diversity Policy.

Workshop aims: After the workshop, participants...

- ... can give examples of what bias is and how it may manifest in teaching and learning
- ... reflect on how to counter bias in their work and study environment
