At least 12 ECTS must be earned during the doctoral program. For this purpose, you will attend compulsory modules (total 9 ECTS) and elective modules (minimum 3 ECTS).

Attendance of the PhD seminar is mandatory for the entire duration of the doctorate.

* If the certificates GCP 1-2 have already been acquired, the module does not have to be completed again and can be replaced by an elective module. 1 ECTS can be awarded if both Journal Clubs are combined or if the Joint Journal Club is attended twice.

** Two Journal Clubs are offered: The Joint Journal Club with Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm (focusing on the health sector) and the Journal Club of the Clinical Trials Center. For registration contact the program coordinator. If the two Journal Clubs are combined, 1 ECTS can be credited.
