This platform, developed by LOOP Zurich, aims to leverage large volumes of data for precision medicine, identify disease patterns, and improve treatment outcomes. By harmonizing and sharing data, the platform will facilitate research, AI development, and potentially lead to national and global advancements in healthcare. Strict data protection regulations will apply to the platform, maximizing its potential for medical research. The platform will meet SPHN standards, allowing health data sharing across Switzerland for research.
